8. Brandon Weckbacher and David Arsenault have resigned from their positions as full time police officers effective today. Ads have been placed on the MMA website and the Maine Criminal Justice Academy website.
9. We finished negotiations between the Town and the Teamsters Union on behalf of the Public Works Department. We expect to have a completed draft for review and approval within the next few weeks.
