1. Police Reports: July 18 - August 7, 2016.
2. June Aquifer Monitoring Report.
3. For the last 3 years, Jonathan Crowe has been the race director for The Dole 3 Miler that has been run on the Mountain Division Rail Trail in August. They raised enough funds to purchase a new sign that has been installed by the Highway crew, and was dedicated to Reverend Dole at the August 6th race this year. Their 2017 race will be held August 5th from 7:00 AM - 10:00 AM. I would like to thank Jonathan Crowe and his group for having this sign made for the Rail Trail.
4. The Green Transfer Station Window Stickers are now being sold at the town office for \$20. The Red stickers expire August 31, 2016.
5. The Western Maine Addiction Recovery Initiative will host a Heroin/Opiate Community Forum at Fryeburg Academy's Leura Eastman Performing Arts Center August 16th from 6 - 8 PM.
6. Letter from Steven Merrill, County Commissioner, District 1. The annual Oxford County Budget Committee caucus for District 1 has been scheduled for 6 PM on Wednesday, August 31st at the Lovell Lions Club, at 2081 Main Street Lovell.
7. Thank you letter from Albert Dubois for issuing the 2 Proclamations for his granddaughter's wedding.
8. Letter from Maine DEP approving the shoreland zoning amendments to the Town of Fryeburg Shoreland Zoning Ordinance, as adopted on June 16, 2016. The amendments comply with State minimum shoreland zoning requirements.

10. We received copy of a Grant offer for IZG's Airport Improvement Program project #18-2016. The total amount of the grant is 741,000 with the ESAA and MEDOT each providing a 5% match of \$37,050.
