1. Police Reports: November 23 - 30.
2. Reminder: Dog Licenses will expire December 31st. A \$25 late charge will be assessed on February 1, 2016. A current rabies certificate is needed and proof of spayed or neutered dogs is required.
3. A Rabies Clinic has been scheduled for January 14, 2016 from 4 pm to 6 pm at the Fryeburg Town Office. The Fryeburg Vet will be administering the vaccination. There will be a \$10 fee. Dogs must be on a leash and cats must be in a carrier.
4. The Christmas Tree Lighting will be held at Bradley Park Sunday December 6th at 6 pm. Refreshments will be served and Santa will be there.
5. Katie submitted the "Open for Business" application to the state November 20th. Copy attached. She did a fantastic job completing the application.
6. Our new truck is not expected to arrive until the end of December. The routes have been adjusted to get the plowing done with our current fleet. This will increase the turnaround time until the truck arrives.
7. 2009 International Truck #2 was picked up from Diesel Works Tuesday. DW towed the truck to their facility to complete the remainder of the work that was started by Don Irish and to perform a Power Unit Preventative Maintenance Service. Additional parts replaced. All of our vehicles and equipment will be scheduled to have regular preventative maintenance service.
8. Red Iron Bridge – I notified the state we have safety concerns with the length and height of the guardrail installed where McNeil Road ends. For the short term, Jersey barriers have been set up on both sides of the guardrail that we believe should be taller and longer because this is the end of a road. Generally guardrails like the ones installed are on the sides of roads.
9. The highway crew picked up trash off Porter Road and at the end of Menotomy by the bog and beach area.

10. All the roads that we close to winter maintenance have now been closed and gated.
