9. Rob Prue, Pine Tree Engineering met with Don and I Monday at Hemlock Bridge Road and inspected all our road jobs.
10. Portland Street Sidewalk: The aprons have been paved on the two driveway entrances off the Portland Street sidewalk to complete the job.
11. Hemlock Bridge Road: The highway crew is working on putting in fill on the sides to grade the sideslopes. Monday Colin Micklon will cut and remove the 3 large Pines and stumps in front of 447 Hemlock Bridge Road. The Town crew will install the culvert at Fern Lane as soon as the trees and stumps are removed.
12. Old River Road: The guard rails have been installed and the work is now complete.
13. Union Hill Road: Fair Point has one pole left to move and the ground work can be complete to finish that job.
