1. Police Reports: April 25 - May 1, 2016.
  2. We ordered (24), 3x5 nylon flags to put up on 23 aluminum pole in the downtown business district on Main Street. The flags will be put on every other pole and will remain up through Veteran's Day. The highway crew will put up the flags and take them down at the end of the season.
  3. Two violation orders issued by the CEO. One is an order to remove a non-compliant deck at 38 Duck Cove Road and the other regarding water and structural issues at 631 Main Street.
