5. The new windows at the legion building have been installed and the roof extension is complete.
6. The stone restoration has been completed at the Village Cemetery and the North and West Fryeburg Cemeteries.
7. The chipping of the wood and brush pile has been scheduled to begin next week.
8. The metal is scheduled to be picked up next week.
9. We have employment ads running for full-time police officers, public works director and a temporary highway position.
10. Thank You – Hunting Dearborn send us a case of Maine grown apples to express their appreciation for the great relationship they have enjoyed over the years.
11. The highway crew finished cleaning the Town's side of the border trees and shrubs that divide the Peary Park property and the Graustein property.

12. The following public notices will be advertised in the Conway Sun and Bridgton paper and are posted on the town web site.
 - a. Winter Parking Ban will be in effect from November 15, 2014 – April 15, 2015 – No vehicles shall be parked on any public street or way from 10 pm to 6 am.
 - b. MRSA 29-A, Section 2396 prohibits any person from placing in the public way snow or slush that has not accumulated there naturally.
 - c. The Town will be closing seven roads with no winter maintenance by the end of November through the end of April 2015. A complete list and site location is posted on the Town web site under the public works department.
13. Fryeburg residents only will be allowed to have up to three (3) 5-gallon buckets of sand per storm for residential use. Sand is not for commercial use and no commercial vehicles are allowed. Four (4) Video Surveillance cameras have been installed on the premises to aid in the prosecution of crimes; including theft of sand/salt from the Town of Fryeburg.
