1. Police Reports: October 6 – 12; October 13 – 19.
2. Household Hazardous Waste Day Saturday October 25th at Fryeburg Transfer Station from 9 to 12 pm.
3. The Librarian and three town office clerks will attend training at MMA in August October 29th. The town office will be closed that day. The Library will be open.
4. Jeff and I attended the Mt. Washington Valley Regional Round Table Advisory Meeting in Conway Friday October 17th. Mark Dubois was one of the guest speakers. Included a copy of the information he presented.
5. Notice received from Fryeburg Rescue Association for a Notice of Public Hearing before the Fryeburg Board of Appeals concerning a Building Variance.
6. Notices from CEO.
7. Cemetery Restoration Update: Expected to be complete by the end of the month.
8. October 27th and 28th the windows will be replaced and roof extension added at the Legion Building.
9. 1,026 transfer station window stickers have been sold.
10. The oil tanks at the Library need to be replaced because they are leaking. I have received some bids and will bring everything to you to discuss at the next meeting.
11. I contacted Lori Bennett, Chair of the Sweden Selectmen. Fryeburg currently plows Sweden's section of Smart's Hill when we plow our section. Sweden pays Fryeburg \$3,000. Both sections are consistent in length. Sweden just contracted with a new plowing contractor. It is closer for them to

plow both sections than it is for us to travel there to plow. We would reverse the agreement with Sweden taking over the plowing and Fryeburg pay \$3,000 if both boards agree.

12. I spoke with Earl Sires, the Town Manager of Conway NH. They will take out the temporary bridge Monday October 27th to install temporary culverts and paving. The road will be closed during the construction and he anticipates the road to be opened Friday October 31st. We will continue to plow under our current agreement. We would not have been able to plow if they didn't fix the bridge. NH would have had to contact someone to plow.
13. The tennis net, benches and backboard will be put in winter storage Friday October 31st.
14. Richard Parmenter resigned his position as Public Works Director. I will be advertising the position by the end of the week and expect to receive applications the week before Thanksgiving, anticipating to have someone on the job by mid December.
