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1. Police Reports: September 5 - 18, 2016.
  2. Residents are required to have the Green Transfer Station Window Sticker to dispose of any trash at the Transfer Station. The stickers are now being sold at the town office for \$20.
  3. Transfer Station "Ecomaine Open House" - Saturday October 1, 2016 from 8 am to 4 pm. Ecomaine will have 11 x 17 posters posted around town to advertise their Open House to provide recycling education to the public at the transfer station. They will have 100, 22-gallon recycling containers to pass out, in addition to other educational supplies. They will raffle "food scrap bins" for composting use.
  4. Household Hazardous Waste Day is scheduled for Saturday October 22<sup>nd</sup> from 9 am to 12 pm at the Fryeburg Transfer Station.
  5. Preliminary 2017 State Valuation from Maine Revenue Services.
  6. July and August building, plumbing and violation list from the Code Officer.
  7. August and September notices from the Assessor and Code Officer.
  8. Thank you card from Ozzie.
  9. The auditors were here for the week of September 12<sup>th</sup> and will return at a later date to complete the work. They are auditing the work for the fiscal year July 31, 2016.
  10. We filed an insurance claim for \$3,092.56 for damage to the police department server and computers as a result of the water damage from the construction at the Rescue Building.
  11. We filed an insurance claim for damage to Engine 93 for \$5,500 for damage to the mirrors, ladders and racks as a result of an accident.
  12. The Town Office will close at 12 noon on Tuesday October 25<sup>th</sup> for a Webinar-On-Line training for the 3 office clerks with the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.
  13. The Town is now the owner of the River Street property next to Weston's Beach. The voters approved purchasing the property at the June 2016 town meeting. Thank you to Dick Krasker for raising the money to purchase this land. We paid \$15,000 for the land and \$915.23 for other closing costs.
